On Tuesday, November 30, 2004 Bishop Brossart High School lost one of its most distinguished alumni members ...Mr. NATHAN SEITER. NATHAN, a 1998 BBHS grad, died as a result of a single car accident near his home in California, Kentucky. His extraordinary life focused on his family, faith, friends, and love for sports and the outdoors. His all-time leading scorer status in basketball and his remarkable baseball records will be respected for years to come at Bishop Brossart.

As a result of the outpouring of contributions and other support, the *NATHAN SEITER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP ENDOWMENT* was established in May 2005. Family members, friends, classmates and alumni have perpetuated NATHAN'S memory with their donations to ultimately provide tuition assistance awards for current students (grades 9-12) attending Bishop Brossart High School.

Designations include:

1. The Endowment provides **FOUR** annual tuition assistance awards totaling **\$1,000.00 each** to be applied toward the winner's tuition obligation to Bishop Brossart High School. Applicants **ARE NOT REQUIRED** to be registered within one of the six district parishes. **ALL BBHS STUDENTS** (grades 9-12) are eligible.
2. The *NATHAN SEITER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP* Selection Committee, designated by the donor(s) and appointed school officials, will select the students (Grades 9-12) to receive the annual awards based on the completed application provided by the student, parent, and other supporting staff.
3. Scholarship awards will be credited toward the student's annual Bishop Brossart tuition notice. Financial need will be the primary consideration in the selection process of all winners.

## **QUALIFICATIONS**

1. To qualify for a *NATHAN SEITER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP*, students must...
  - a. Display good character and respect toward others,
  - b. Continue the established moral discipline and academic standards while a student at Bishop Brossart High School,
  - c. Participate in any of the school's activities, clubs and organizations as designated on the application form.

## **REQUIREMENTS**

**To be eligible for a 2011-12 *NATHAN SEITER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP* the following information must be submitted no later than September 12, 2011.**

1. Completed and signed application form.

2. A PERSONAL essay (250 words or less) ...**Describe and state how this award will assist you in achieving a high school education at Bishop Brossart High School. Include involvement in volunteer activities, clubs and organizations you are involved.** Essay must be in the student's own words.
3. A PARENT FINANCIAL SUMMARY...**Your parent(s) or guardian must complete this section. Summarize the family's obligations and resources to illustrate the need for financial assistance to attend BBHS and the effort to meet these needs.** Summary may be written on the application form or submitted in a computer-generated word document form.
4. Applicant must request a recommendation of a BBHS Teacher / Staff member.
