2. Boys **must** wear a coat and tie for one pose. That pose will appear in the yearbook and on the class composite.
3. Girls **must** use the provided drape for one pose. That pose will appear in the yearbook and on the class composite. Other outfits for subsequent poses are fine.
4. Backgrounds for the yearbook and composite poses cannot have decorations such as flowers, etc. that would be inconsistent with other senior pictures.

National World Language Exam Results

French students at Bishop Brossart High School ranked nationally in the 76th annual event, according to Lisa Narug, National Director of *Le Grand Concours*. The American Association of Teachers of French sponsors this competition. The purpose of the *National French Contest* is to help stimulate further interest in the teaching and learning of French and to help identify and reward achievement on the part of both students and teachers. Students are evaluated for their written, oral and listening skills in French. Over 100,100 students in 50 states competed in the 2011 event.
