## Scholarships & Financial Aid

### SCHOLARSHIPS AND FINANCIAL AID

Bishop Brossart has one of the lowest (In-District) tuitions (\$5,180 / 2010-2011) of any private school in Greater Cincinnati. BUT, TUITION ONLY COVERS 87% OF THE ACTUAL \$5,915 COST TO EDUCATE A STUDENT.

The remaining \$735 per student or over \$263,000 (based on 358 students) is raised by the various school clubs, committees and organizations including: Alumni, Development Committee, PTU and Student Council...TO HELP KEEP TUITION AS LOW AS POSSIBLE.

Also, to assist families, the school offers various scholarships and financial aid programs which include:

### PLACEMENT EXAM SCHOLARSHIPS AND AWARDS

As a result of the student's Diocesan Placement Exam scores, Bishop Brossart High School will award the following scholarship grants in January for academic achievement:

- A) 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Highest scores - \$1,000 per year for 3 years
- B) 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Highest scores - \$1,000 per year for 2 years
- C) 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> Highest scores - \$1,000 1<sup>st</sup> year/\$500 2<sup>nd</sup> year
- D) 7<sup>th</sup> Highest score - \$1,000 1<sup>st</sup> year
- E) **THREE \$500 scholarships** will be offered to students who take the Placement Exam at BBHS and whose names will be drawn at random.

\* *If any of the above (A, B, C, D, E) scholarships are not accepted*

*the next highest scores or other names will be drawn until all scholarships have been awarded/accepted.*

\* *Scholarship winners (A, B, C, D, E) will have 2 weeks after the announcement to decide. After 2 weeks, new awards will be made.*

### TUITION ASSISTANCE

Application packets for tuition assistance can be picked up in the main office at any time. Application deadline is June 1. Tuition assistance is available to all registered students. ALL INFORMATION REGARDING TUITION ASSISTANCE IS TREATED WITH UTMOST CONCERN FOR CONFIDENTIALITY.

### FAMILY TUITION RATES

A family tuition rate (for two or more high school students in the same family attending BBHS) shall be \$400.00 less than twice the single rate. Out-of-District rates apply according to diocesan policy, that is, 10% above In-District rates. Family rates will be invoiced equally to each family member. Adjustments will be made in case of withdrawals.

### LARGE FAMILY DISTRICT DISCOUNT

Registered and supporting members of any parish in the BBHS district of southern Campbell County may apply for this discount. LARGE FAMILY is defined as having three (3) or more students in the district schools, with at least one student enrolled at BBHS and one in a participating district parish grade school.

The discount amount shall be:

BBHS \$300.00 per family

Participating District Parish Grade School \$200.00 per family

Families excluded from this discount are as follows:

- 1.) Families who apply for and receive Financial Aid at any of the schools.
- 2.) Teachers (High School or Grade School) and staff personnel who receive the professional courtesy discount.

The **BERTRAM FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP** will be awarded to an incoming Freshman. The Bertram scholarship is worth \$400. The scholarship is based on academic aptitude and achievement as well as need. Write or call for an application after April 1<sup>st</sup>. The applicant must be registered for the upcoming school year.

The **ROBERT A. & MARION V. MUNNINGHOFF SCHOLARSHIPS** (Minimum \$500 each) will be awarded to FOUR incoming Freshmen. Contact your grade school principal in January for application and guidelines. Deadline will be posted in the application.

The **MICHAEL C. NELTNER SCHOLARSHIPS** were established in November 2000. Incoming Freshmen, as well as current students are eligible. Last year, FOUR \$1,300 tuition assistance grants were awarded. Contact your grade school principal in January for application. Deadline will be posted in the application.

The **DOROTHY MUEHLENKAMP SCHOLARSHIPS...** This new scholarship was established as a Charitable Remainder Trust that awards FOUR \$1,000.00 tuition assistance grants at each of the Campbell County Catholic high schools. Winners must be a 9th grade student from a district parish who attended a Catholic elementary school within the district. Applications are available in September in the BBHS main office.

The **JACK McGARR SCHOLARSHIP** for tuition assistance is available to incoming freshmen and students currently enrolled at Bishop Brossart. **STUDENTS RECEIVING OTHER SCHOLARSHIP GRANTS FROM BBHS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE.** Last year, FIVE grants of \$750 each were awarded. Application process for incoming freshmen will be announced in April through grade school principals.

The **AL KELLER III SCHOLARSHIP** was established in 2003 to compliment BBHS students who demonstrate an appreciation and talent for Art. The scholarship provides TWO \$500 tuition assistance awards annually to current Brossart students. Contact the Guidance Office at 635-2108 ext. 126 for application process.

The **KATHLEEN LUSCHEK SCHOLARSHIP** was established in January 2004 for an incoming freshman and an eligible BBHS Student (grades 9-11) from Sts. Peter & Paul Parish. Each scholarship is a \$500 award. Applications will be available at the Sts. Peter & Paul main office and at BBHS in early March.

The **NATHAN SEITER SCHOLARSHIP** was established in May 2005. The endowment provides FOUR annual tuition assistance awards of \$1,000 each. ALL BBHS students (Grades 9-12) are eligible and *are not required to be registered within one of the six district parishes.* Application deadline is September.

The **LINDSEY SENDELBACH SCHOLARSHIP** (\$1,000 Annual Award) was established in 2006 to be presented to an incoming BBHS Freshman student from St. Joseph Camp Springs Grade School. The fund also presents a \$1,000 award to a BBHS Graduating senior. Applications will be available in the grade school office in March.
