SNOWBALL -RULES & REGULATIONS

1. SENIORS, JUNIORS, AND SOPHOMORES may attend (SENIORS, JUNIORS and SOPHOMORES may attend without a date).
2. FRESHMEN may attend, if invited by an upperclassmen from Bishop Brossart High School. Parents are requested to please help on this point, especially with regard to the restriction as it applies to students from other schools.
3. Controlled substances (including alcohol) are expressly forbidden. These items will be confiscated at the door at the time of arrival. Parents will be notified and requested to pick up their child; the students or graduates will not be permitted to enter the dance. Furthermore, the student will be suspended for three(3) days and liable to expulsion, if the circumstances warrant such action, and there will be no refund of money.
 - a. Should any student be found to be 'under the influence', parents will be notified to pick up their child immediately. If parents cannot be reached, the police will be notified to escort the student home. The student will be suspended for three (3) days and liable to expulsion, if the circumstances warrant. Please note that we will consider it our duty to notify the parents of the person's date, also.
 - b. This rule also applies to older persons who may have graduated.
4. Smoking is NOT permitted. Cigarettes will be confiscated.
5. No drinks (opened or unopened) may be brought into the dance – this includes, but not limited to, sports drinks, coffee, bottled water and soda.
6. Students will be expected to arrive at the Snowball within one hour after the dance starts. No one will be admitted after this. Parents will be notified immediately of their child's absence from the Snowball. Students will not be permitted to go to the cars for forgotten cameras, flowers, etc., nor will they be allowed to leave before midnight without parent notification.
7. Students will not be permitted to gather in the parking lots. They must either come into the dance or leave the grounds. Arrival in the parking lot will not be considered as 'arrival at the dance' (refer #5). However, rule number 3 will extend to the parking lot.
8. Any behavior, including dancing, that could be considered lewd or harmful to others, is not permitted. If violators do not respond to a warning, they will be asked to leave and possibly be barred from future dances.
If it is necessary to eject a student, parents will be notified first.
9. General admonitions:
 - a. The Snowball is sponsored by the school so as to provide the students with an opportunity to enjoy a formal social event. It can be a source of many happy memories. Please conduct yourself in such a way that this event is not a source of embarrassment or injury to you, your date, your parents, your school or any other interested person or institution.
 - b. The administration and faculty sincerely hope that the Snowball will be a very happy experience.
 - c. Please do not seek to subvert these rules nor to be treated as the exception to them.
 - d. The school does not sanction any activity (PARTY, MEAL, ETC.) before or after the dance.
 - e. Persons leaving the Snowball for any reasons may not return.
 - f. While this is a formal affair, it is hoped that good judgment will prevail in the area of purchasing or renting clothing. We advise against the expensive rental of clothing, and it is not mandatory that a gown or suit be purchased. However, a coat and tie is expected for gentlemen attending. Jeans, boots, or gym shoes will not be permitted.
